Quick Update on Progress and Priorities

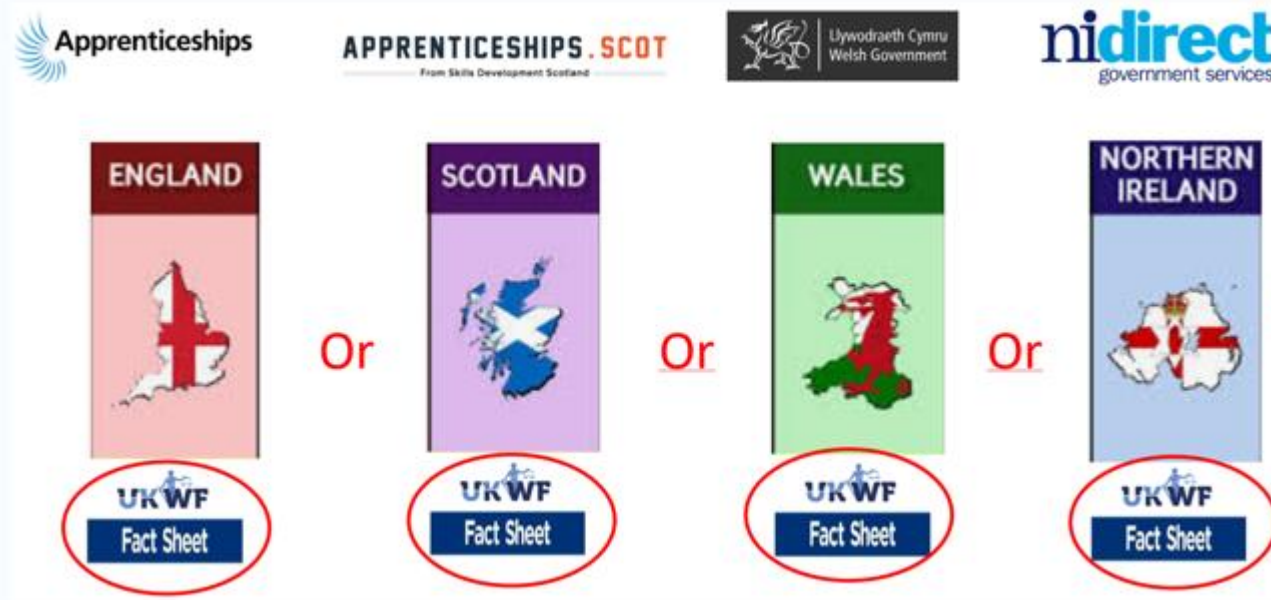
- Those of you who saw the last update will remember:

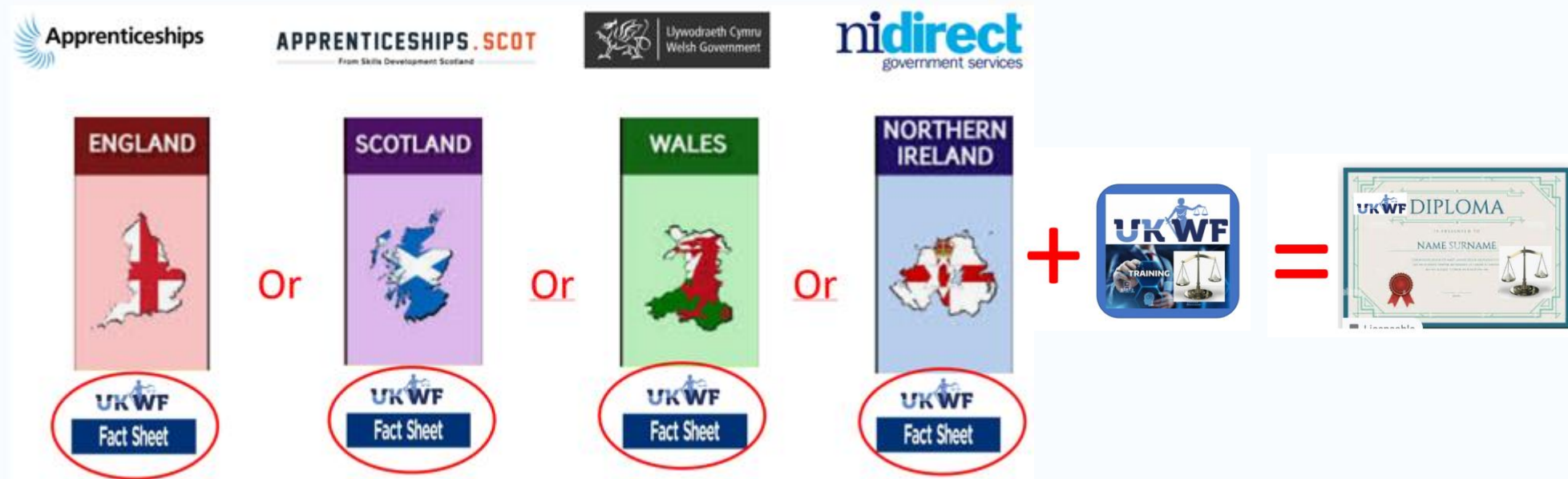
- We will create and execute a UKWF Metrology training Module

Quick Update on Progress and Priorities



Progress since the last meeting:

- Agreed the course content through the Member Survey (thank you again, those who responded)
- Agreed the length of all of the sub-modules
- Completed the “Fact Sheet” for members (this will be circulated shortly)
- Re-prioritised slightly:
 - Moved the focus towards introducing the “Certificate” first (i.e. existing employees, not Apprentices)
 - This is purely because an Apprenticeship takes at least a year, normally 2-3 years, so there is no urgency – it just needs to be in places before Apprentices finish their Apprenticeships
 - We are still working out the member pricing, it will be dependent on the delivery method (e.g. on-line will be cheaper than in-person) and also the number of attendees



Next Steps

- Apprentices (Diploma):
 - If you want to recruit an Apprentice, start now!
 - Obtain the fact sheet and start the process with a selected scheme provider
- Existing Employee Training (Certificate):
 - We will confirm the pricing as soon as we can
 - In the meantime, in order to gauge the level of interest, we will contact all members to ask how many employees would they like to put through the Certificate program
- Our plan remains to be running our first training courses by September 2023!
